ENGAGEMENT ORDER



TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The Sikshya Sahayak / Junior Teacher should join in the concerned school by dt.10.7.2019 failing which the engagement order shall be automatically stand cancelled.
2. The contract of engagement commences from the date of joining and continues till 31st day of March 2020.
3. The contract of engagement will be renewed by Collector & District Magistrate, Koraput in the subsequent years in favour of concerned Siksha Sahayak /Junior Teacher basing on positive certificate of the School Managing Committee of concerned School in favour of the concerned SS, regular attendance and satisfactory teaching.
4. The Sikhaya Sahayak shall be removed from engagement with a prior notice of 30(thirty) days, if he /she violates the conditions of the contract on the basis of the adverse report of the School Managing Committee or submission of fraudulent testimonials or if he/she is involved in criminal cases or if he/she remains absent unauthorised or misconduct.
5. The Siksya Sahayaks will get consolidated monthly remuneration as decided by the Govt. from time to time.
6. The Sikhya Sahayak should attend training programme as may be fixed by Govt. from time to time.
7. The engagement would be on the basis of annual contract. In case Collector decides not to renew the contract appeal shall lie to the Govt. within three months of non-renewal of contract.
8. The Sikshya Sahayak shall be eligible for casual leave of 12 (Twelve)days during one Calender year. He/she shall not be entitled to any other authorised absence beyond the above mentioned period. If he/she remains absent with permission and if he/she does not have any authorised leave at his/her credit, the proportionate amount from consolidated remuneration shall be deducted.
9. Any lady Siksha Sahayak who is having less than two surviving children is entitled to avail leave on account of maternity as decided by Govt. from time to time.
10. The agreement as prescribed by Govt. between the Collector and Siksha Sahayak is to be executed on stamped paper.
11. Funds as required for remuneration of Siksha Sahayak for the District will be placed with the Collector, who shall pay to the Siksha Sahayak.
12. No Travelling Allowance will be allowed to join in the new place of engagement.
13. The Siksha Sahayak shall perform the following duties.
 - i. The Teaching in the school shall be the main duty of the Siksha Sahayak.
 - ii. He/she must maintain regularity and punctuality in attending school.
 - iii. He/she must ensure completion of entire curriculum within the specified time.
 - iv. He/she must assess the learning ability of each child and accordingly supplement additional instructions if any as required.

- v. He/she must ensure minimum level of learning (M.I.L) for the students as prescribed by the Competent Authority (ST & SC Dev. Depatt./School & Mass Education Department) .
- vi. He/she must ensure at least 90 % attendance of the children in respective schools in all classes.
- vii. He/she shall reduce the dropout of the children in school below 10 %.
- viii. He/she shall motivate the parents/guardians of the village in which primary school is situated for enrolment of children within the age group of 6 to 14 years . It shall be his/her duty to contact parents/guardians in case children fail to attend classes regularly and get such children back to the classes .
- ix. He/she will hold regular meeting with parents and guardians and apprise them about the regularity in attendance , ability to learn, progress made in learning and any relevant information about the children.
- x. He/she shall abide by the rationalisation of teachers policy of Govt.as issued from time to time.
- xi. Whenever applicable he/she will work under the administrative control of Headmaster/Headmistress in charge of the school to which he/she assigned. He/she shall perform the duties as will be entrusted upon him/her by the concerned Headmaster/Headmistress.
- xii. He/she may be assigned any other work in furtherance of the objective of universalisation or any other authority as decided by Govt. in SSD & Mass Education Deptt. from time to time.
- xiii. The engagement shall be cancelled, if any fraudulent testimonial is detected in future,if he/she is criminally proceeded against.
