General eligibility:

- He/ She must be a citizen of India.
- He/ She must be able to speak, read and write Odia and must have passed the high School Certificate Examination or equivalent with Odia as principal subject or passed Odia test equivalent to M.E. School standard conducted by the Education Department of Odisha.
- Candidates having Bachelors' Degree in Arts /Commerce / Science with Bachelors' Degree in Education from any University of the State or its equivalency are eligible. Regarding Universities / Institutions of outside State, the candidates shall only be eligible for engagement after verification of genuineness of their educational / training qualification from concerned University / Institution from which they have obtained the Degree.
- Such outside University/ Institution pass out candidates shall have to produce the authenticated proof of equivalency and NCTE recognition in support of their qualification at the time of verification failing which their cases will not be entertained.
- He/ She must not have more than one spouse living.

1. Age:

He/ She must be below 32 Yrs. and above 21 Yrs. of age on **01.01.2020** provided the maximum age limit shall be relaxed by 05 years in case of candidates belong to the ST, SC, SEBC & Women candidates. Age shall be relaxed for Ex-service man as per Odisha Ex-Service Men Rule, 1989. In case of PH candidate, the upper age shall be relaxed by 10 years.

2. Academic and Professional Qualification :

- B.A. B.Ed. Teacher-** He / She ^{must} have obtained bachelor degree in Arts / Commerce (with two school subjects) from a recognized university with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) along with a degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university with OSSTET.
- B.Sc. B.Ed. Teacher –** He / She must have obtained bachelor degree in Science (CBZ) (with two school subjects) from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) along with a Degree in Bachelor in Education (a course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University with OSSTET.

- (c) **Sanskrit Teacher**- Bachelor Degree with Sanskrit as one of the elective / optional / Honours / Pass subject from a recognized University with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) with Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized University/ Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university with OSSTET.

OR

Shastri (Sanskrit) with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) from recognized university and Sikshya Shastri (Sanskrit) (a course prescribed by NCTE) from a recognized University / Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university with OSSTET.

OR

Acharya (Except Jyotishacharya and Ayurvedacharya) or Sahityacharya with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized University with OSSTET.

OR

Bachelors' Degree with Sanskrit as one of the optional / Honours. Subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Sanskrit with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized university with OSSTET.

- (d) **Hindi Teacher** – Bachelor's Degree from a recognized University with Hindi as one of the elective subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ ST/ PH/SEBC candidates) or with Rastrabhasa Ratna from Rastrabhasa Prachar Samiti, Wardha or with Sastri from Odisha Rastrabhasa Parisada, Puri or with Snataka (Acquired by June 2005 the date up to which the temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikhya Samiti, Odisha, Cuttack or an equivalent Degree from a recognized institution with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) and Hindi Sikhyan Parangat from a Institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University/ B.Ed. In Hindi (a course prescribed by NCTE) from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, and institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized University with OSSTET.

OR

Bachelors' Degree with Hindi as one of the optional / Honours. Subject with minimum 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) and M.A. in Hindi with minimum 50% marks in aggregate from a recognized university with OSSTET.

- (e) **PET**- +2 or its equivalent examination with minimum 50 % marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidates) and CPed/B.P.Ed/M.P.Ed from a recognized Board / University with OSSTET.

The B.Ed./ Sikshya Shastri candidates should have registered their names either in the Employment Bureau located at Vanivihar, Bhubaneswar / Jyoti Vihar, Sambalpur / Bhanja Vihar, Berhampur / OUAT, Bhubaneswar or in the State Employment Exchange, Bhubaneswar or in any District Employment Exchange. The candidates for PET should have registered their names in the Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/she belongs to/ State Employment Exchange. SC/ST and PH candidates should have registered their name in the Special Employment Exchange for SC/ST & PH at Bhubaneswar or in any Employment Exchange located in the concerned Revenue District which he/she belongs to.

3. Reservation:-

The Odisha Reservation of Vacancies (in posts and service for ST&SC) Act, 1975 and the Odisha Reservation of Posts & Services for Socially & Educationally Backward Classes Act, 2008 and the rules made there under and such other principles of the post based reservation as prescribed by the State Government on the land mark judgment of Hon'ble High Court/Supreme Court, from time to time, shall be followed.

One third of the notified vacancies will be reserved for Women Candidates of respective categories. Similarly 4% will be reserved for Physically Handicapped as per the provision of Section-33 of the "Persons with disabilities" (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation Act), 1% for eminent sports personnel and 3% for Ex-Serviceman.

Instructions contained in SSEPD Deptt. Resolution No. 7140/ Dtd. 05.09.2017 shall be adhered to for (PWDs) candidates.

The PH candidates shall be referred to the Appellate Medical Board constituted by W&CD Department vide Notification No. 1643/WCD/Dtd.06.09.2011 for re-examination. Engagement order shall be issued if such candidates found genuine by the Board.

4. Emoluments & Service Condition :-

The emoluments and service conditions shall be guided as per the provisions of G.A. Deptt. Notification No.32010/Gen/Dtd. 12.11.2013 & No. 19569/Gen. /Dtd. 12.09.2017 & No. 19574/Gen./Dtd. 12.09.2017.

5. Remuneration:-

The contractual Teaching & Non-teaching staff will be paid following consolidated remuneration as per Govt. in Finance Deptt. Letter No. 28090/F/Dt. 22.09.2017.

7. Selection Procedure :-

The selection will be made by the District Selection Committee headed by the Collector, Koraput, Project Administrator, ITDA, Koraput / Jeypore, Inspector of Schools(SSD), Koraput, District Inspector of Schools (SSD), Koraput and District Welfare Officer, Koraput (Member Convener) are the members of the committee.

(a) Selection procedure

Selection shall be made only on merit i.e. on the basis of percentage of marks.

After verification, Merit List (150%) shall be prepared for each category of candidates on the basis of the percentage of marks secured in H.S.C. Examination (without extra optional if any), BA/B.Com/B.Sc. (without Ancillary & Foundation courses if any) & B.Ed. Examination in case of TGT (Arts & Science Teacher) and in case of Sanskrit, Hindi, PET, (without extra optional / Ancillary & Foundation courses if any), the percentage of marks secured by a candidate in each qualifying examination.

- (i) In case of two or more candidates secured the same marks the candidate older in age will be placed above in the rank.
- (ii) If there is further tie, the higher percentage of marks secured in training qualification will be taken in to account.
- (iii) Higher education will not be given any weightage during preparation of merit list in all categories.
