GUIDELINES FOR EMPANELMENT OF TEACHERS ON CONTRACTUAL BASIS TO MEET URGENCIES FOR ODISHA ADARSHA VIDYALAYA (OAVS)

ESSENTIAL ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE

POST GRADUATE TEACHER (PGT)

Two years integrated post graduate course of regional college of education of NCERT in the concerned subject, with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidate) in the following subject; OR

Master Degree in the concerned subject from a recognized university with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidate) in the English.

PGT (MATHEMATICS):

- **1.** Bachelor degree in education (A course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university
- 2. Proficiency in teaching both in Odia and English medium.
- 3. Desirable knowledge of computer applications.
- 4. Note: Candidates having special B.Ed or D.Ed are not eligible for the post of PGTs.

PGT (ENGLISH):

- **5.** Bachelor degree in education (A course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university
- 6. Proficiency in teaching both in Odia and English medium.
- 7. Desirable knowledge of computer applications.
- 8. Note: Candidates having special B.Ed or D.Ed are not eligible for the post of PGTs.

TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHER (TGT)

Four years integrated degree course of regional college of education of NCERT in the concerned subject, with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidate):

OR

Bachelor's degree in Arts and Science in the concerned subjects with 50% in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidate) along with a degree in bachelor in education (A course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university.

TGT (HINDI):

1. Bachelor degree in Arts with Hindi as Honours subject

AND

2. Hindi Teacher Training Certificate Course (BH. Ed) conducted by the Hindi Teachers Training Institute, Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and Sambalpur, Hindi Sikhyan Parangata from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra and B.Ed in Hindi. (A course prescribed by NCTE from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliation to a recognized university) will be considered as training gualification.

OR

3. B. A. with honours in any subject with Hindi as subject for all three years.

AND

4. Hindi Teacher Training Certificate Course (BH. Ed) conducted by the Hindi Teachers Training Institute, Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and Sambalpur, Hindi Sikhyan Parangata from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra and B.Ed in Hindi. (A course prescribed by NCTE from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliation to a recognized university) will be considered as training qualification.

OR

5. BA with honours in any subject with Snataka (acquired by June-2005 the date up to which temporary recognition has been granted) from Hindi Sikhya samiti Odisha Cuttack.

AND

6. Hindi Teacher Training Certificate Course (BH. Ed) conducted by the Hindi Teachers Training Institute, Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and Sambalpur, Hindi Sikhyan Parangata from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra and B.Ed in Hindi. (A course prescribed by NCTE from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliation to a recognized university) will be considered as training qualification.

OR

7. BA with honours in any subject with equivalent degree in Hindi from recognized institution/university.

AND

- 8. Hindi Teacher Training Certificate Course (BH. Ed) conducted by the Hindi Teachers Training Institute, Cuttack, Bhubaneswar and Sambalpur, Hindi Sikhyan Parangata from Kendriya Hindi Sansthan, Agra and B.Ed in Hindi. (A course prescribed by NCTE from Dakhin Bharat Hindi Prachar Sabha, Madras, an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliation to a recognized university) will be considered as training qualification.
- 9. Proficiency in teaching in Odia and English medium.
- 10. Desirable knowledge of computer applications.

TGT (SANSKRIT)

- 1. Bachelor's degree in Arts with Sanskrit as a subject.
- 2. Proficiency in teaching both in Odia and English medium.
- 3. Desirable knowledge of computer applications.
- 4. Note: Candidates having special B.Ed or D.Ed are not eligible for the post of PGTs. AND

Bachelor in education (A course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university.

SPECIAL PROVISION

- Relaxation of B.Ed. qualification: in the absence of suitable candidates with B.Ed. degree in Hard/Very Hard station candidates with following qualification may be considered in different categories without B.Ed. qualification.
 - a) Post-graduate with 60% marks in Arts subject and 55% in Humanities subject may be considered for the post of PGTs, if suitable candidates with B.Ed. are not available.
 - b) Similarly in the case of TGTs, Arts with 60% marks and BA with 55% marks may be considered for appointment on part time contractual basis, if suitable candidates with B.Ed. are not available.
- Relaxation in CTET: In the absence of CTET qualified candidates, candidates without CTET qualification may be considered if otherwise eligible.
