ESSENTIAL ACADEMIC QUALIFICATION AND EXPERIENCE

TRAINED GRADUATE TEACHER (TGT)

Four years integrated degree course of regional college of education of NCERT in the concerned subject, with at least 50% marks in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidate):

OR

Bachelor's degree in Arts and Science in the concerned subjects with 50% in aggregate (45% for SC/ST/PH/SEBC candidate) along with a degree in bachelor in education (A course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university.

TGT (ENGLISH):

- 1. Bachelor degree in education (A course prescribed by NCTE) from an institution recognized by NCTE and affiliated to a recognized university
- Proficiency in teaching both in Odia and English medium.

3. Desirable knowledge of computer applications.

4. Note: Candidates having special B.Ed or D.Ed are not eligible for the post of TGTs.

TGT (HINDI):

SPECIAL PROVISION

- Relaxation of B.Ed. qualification: in the absence of suitable candidates with B.Ed.
 degree in Hard/Very Hard station candidates with following qualification may be considered in different categories without B.Ed. qualification.
 - a. Post-graduate with 60% marks in Arts subject and 55% in Humanities subject may be considered for the post of PGTs, if suitable candidates with B.Ed. are not available.
 - b. Similarly in the case of TGTs, Arts with 60% marks and BA with 55% marks may be considered for appointment on part time contractual basis, if suitable candidates with B.Ed. are not available.
- Relaxation in CTET: In the absence of CTET qualified candidates, candidates without CTET qualification may be considered if otherwise eligible.
