**SEALED TENDER CALL NOTICE FOR AUCTION SALE OF GOVT.
VEHICLE NO. OR 10 2397 OF I.C.D.S PROJECT, LAMTAPUT**

In pursuance of the order of authorization vide Letter No. 1330 dated 03.08.2019 of District Social Welfare Officer, Koraput, the sealed tenders in the prescribed formats are invited by the undersigned from the intending tenderers for auction sale of this Office Govt. Vehicle Model No. MM/4/ FRP Mahindra & Mahindra Jeep bearing Registration No. OR 10 2397 on "as is where is basis" condition. The upset price of the above vehicle has been fixed to Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees twenty five thousand). The last date for receipt of sealed tenders is 21.08.2019 (Wednesday) by 5.00 PM. The intending bidders may inspect the vehicle at the garage of the vehicle of I.C.D.S Project, Lamtaput on any working day. For more details the intending tenderers may also visit the web site www.koraput.nic.in.

TERMS & CONDITIONS:

1. The intending bidders are advised to submit the sealed tenders in a single cover which should accompany with the amount of Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 1,000/- (Rupees one thousand) only in shape of Bank Drafts payable at SBI, Machkund in favour of Child Development Project Officer, Lamtaput and the cover should be superscribed as "Tender for Vehicle". The EMD amount will be refunded immediately to the unsuccessful tenderers only after finalization of the tenders.
2. Offers received within the dateline shall be opened on 22.08.2019 (Thursday) at 11.00 AM and considered in presence of tenderers or their authorized agents and the committee members. After that no tenders will be entertained/ considered. Further, the tenders who have not duly filled and not having valid Bank Draft towards EMD amount shall liable to be rejected.
3. The highest offer at or the above the upset price shall be approved by the competent authority then and there. The highest tenderer shall deposit 25% of the auctioned sale amount immediately and the balance 75% within 7 days of the approval of the offer.

4. If minimum price is not available by sealed tender, the competent authority may dispose the vehicle through negotiation at a price of not less than the highest price offered by the highest tenderer.
5. On failure to make payment as aforesaid deposits (including EMD) shall be forfeited and the vehicle put to fresh tender as the case may be.
6. The vehicle shall not be delivered to the tenderer until after realization of auctioned or negotiated amount and before completion of requisite formalities. Tools, instruments and spare parts shall not be delivered with the vehicle.
7. The sale proceeds shall be deposited in Govt. Treasury under the receipt head **"0235-Social Security and Welfare-60-Other Social Security & Welfare Programme-800-Other Receipts"**.
8. The tenderer shall remove the vehicle from the site within 7 days from the date of depositing the full amount of tender or negotiated amount. The custody or safe guard of the vehicle shall be the responsibility of the tenderer and no claim or complaint on that account shall be admissible.
9. On failure to remove the vehicle within the time as aforesaid, ground rent @1% of the auctioned amount shall be charged for each day or part of the day till the removal of the vehicle from the site.
10. If the ground rent so charged exceeds the sale price deposited, the tenderer shall cease to have any right on the vehicle and the amount deposited by the tenderer shall be adjusted towards the ground rent and vehicle shall become absolute property of Government free from all encumbrances and disposed of by fresh sealed tender as the case may be.
