The detail of date wise food requirements & menu specifications are given in the statement. Intending Caterers/food suppliers having GST approval, FSSAI certified and 5 years previous experience in large scale events may apply in the District Culture Office, Koraput by hand/by post with specifications mentioned below during office hours from 10.00 A.M. to 5.00 P.M. by 06.12.2022. The quotations will be opened on the same day in the conference Hall of Chief Development Officer-cum-Executive Officer, Zilla Parishad, Koraput at 5.00 PM in presence of the quotationers or their representatives.

The intending Caterer or Food Supplier shall quote the specific rate of breakfast, lunch, dinner **separately** including one dining hall of 100' X 50' ft with 12 numbers of round tables and chairs, one kitchen set, with provision of light, Generator, one hundred chairs for sitting purpose, utensils, three distribution tables and service persons with proper uniform.
