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SECTION –II
GENERAL INFORMATION FOR CONTRACTOR.

2-1. BRIEF DESCRIPTION ON THE WORK.

(i) To Construction of Electrification of LT line work at which includes the supply of materials and labour component as mentioned in Technically Sanctioned estimates.

(ii) To handover the work to the concerned TPSODL authority after completion of works.

2-2 ELIGIBILITY.

(i) The contractor should have valid Electrical HT Licenses and valid ELBO licenses No. and license should be for a period at least 3 months from the date of the opening of the tender.

(ii) The contractor should have valid GST clearance certificate (Form No.612) and PAN issued by I.T. Department.

(iii) The successful bidder has to produce valid Labour license after the agreement.

2-3 SALE, DROPPING, OPENING OF TENDER:

The cost of tender paper, the date and time of selling, dropping of tender paper has been mentioned in the Tender Call Notice. The venue, time and date of opening of the tender has also been mentioned in the Tender Call Notice.

2-4 AGREEMENT:-

The successful tenderer has to execute agreements with Chairman R.M.C Jeypore as follows:

‘-Agreement in PWD form No. P1. (to be borne by the contractor)

Besides above, all the terms and conditions mentioned in this paper would be the part of the agreement of the contractor with Chairman R.M.C Jeypore.

2-5. The amount quoted by the contractor should be either less than or equal to the tender cost of the project and in no case the tender amount which is more than the tender cost, will be approved by Chairman R.M.C Jeypore.

SECTION-III
GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITION (For both Electrical & Civil)

3.1- DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED:

The sealed tender papers should be submitted with following documents:-

(i) Original tender papers as received from the Chairman R.M.C Jeypore with signature on each page.

The R.M.C Jeypore will not be responsible in case there is any missing of any page. The original copy available at Chairman R.M.C Jeypore will be the final in this case.

(ii) EMD as mentioned in the tender call notice, in shape of A/c. payee Bank Draft/ Banker's Cheque issued by any Nationalised Bank in favour of Secretary R.M.C Jeypore payable at Jeypore.

(iii) Attested copy of valid H.T license by ELBO Odisha.

(iv) Attested copy of valid GST clearance certificate on Form 612.

(v) Attested copy of PAN issued by I.T. Department.

Original copies of license, GST clearance, PAN etc. may be required to be produced before R.M.C Jeypore as and when requested by Chairman, RMC Jeypore.

3-2- EXPERIENCE CERTIFICATE :- The tender may also be accompanied with experience certificate on successful completion of similar type of works issued by an officer not less than the rank of Executive Engineer.

3-3- SIGNATURE OF TENDERER.

In case the tenderer is described as a proprietorship firm the tender shall be signed by the proprietor in the name of the firm or by a person holding power of attorney to do so on behalf of the proprietor.

In case the tenderer is a partnership firm the tender shall be signed by each partner or by a person holding power of attorney authorizing him to do so on behalf of all the partners of the firm.

In case the tenderer is a company the tender shall be executed in the manner laid down in the said company's Article of Association.

For liasoning with Chairman R.M.C Jeypore during the execution of the work, receipt of payments etc., the above procedure is to be followed.

3-4-SEALED TENDER:

The tender must be submitted in a sealed envelope duly superscribed ~~with the name of the project~~ name of the work and Tender call Notice no. Besides these there should be no other writings on the envelope.

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3-5- QUOTED RATE AND AMOUNT:

The tenderer should quote his rates and amount of items on the price bid in both figure ~~words~~ ^{Words} in English language only and should use ball pen for filling the tender paper.

In case of any discrepancy occurs between words and figures mentioned by the tenderer for rate or amount the words shall be taken in to consideration towards finalization of the tender.

3-6. VALIDITY OF TENDER:

The tender submitted shall remain valid for 30 days from the date of opening of the tender and may be extended at the discretion of the Chairman R.M.C Jeypore.

3-7 TIME OF COMPLETION:

The completion period of the entire work is 30(thirty) days from the date of handing over of site by Engineer-Incharge of RMC Jeypore.

3-8- SUPPLY OF MATERIALS.

The contractor shall make his own arrangements for procurement of all materials, equipments, T&P etc. The materials supplied by the contractor shall confirm to the specifications mentioned in the technically sanctioned estimates. The contractor shall make all arrangements of his own for proper storage of materials at site and cost of storage will be borne by the contractor. The transformer to be installed should comply with BIS standards IS 1180(part-1) 2014, BIS Level -2, Star-2 Outdoor type. The contractor shall produce the bill of materials purchased and money receipts which are to be produced before TPSODL for verification.

3-9. GUARANTEE:

The contractor shall furnish a guarantee to the effect that all items of the work (Both parts) constructed and supplied by him shall be free from any defect both in terms of materials and workmanship for a period of not less than 18(eighteen) months from the date of handing over to RMC Jeypore.

During this period the contractor shall replace the defective materials if any or rectify the defects if any at his own cost as pointed out by the Chairman R.M.C Jeypore to the satisfaction of the later within the time period intimated by the later. If the contractor fails to rectify the faults properly within the time period allotted for the larger interest of farmers utility the Chairman R.M.C Jeypore may appoint any other contractor to rectify the faults or may rectify departmentally and the cost so involved will be deducted from the security money of the original contractor. This cost of rectification will be decided by Chairman R.M.C Jeypore as found suitable by him and the original contractor will have no challenge to it.

3-10. SECURITY DEPOSIT.

The successful tenderer shall deposit 2% of the accepted tendered amount deducting the EMD earlier deposited within a specified period from the date of issue of the letter intent to him of acceptance of his tender and sign the agreement.

The total amount of security money deposited by the contractor shall be 5% (Five percent) of the accepted tender amount. The balance security amount will be made up by deducting 3% (three percent) of the amount of the gross payment of the bill.

3-12- RELEASE OF SECURITY DEPOSIT:

The security deposit amount will be considered for refund to the contractor only after completion of guarantee period.

3-13-PAYMENT:

Payment to the contractor shall be made as per "First & Final bill" basis. The bill shall be paid after successful trial of the Project and handing over of the project to Chairman R.M.C Jeypore.

3-14. EXTENTION OF TIME OF COMPLETION:

If the contractor shall desire an extension of the time for completion of work on the ground of his having been un-avoidable hindered in its execution or any other ground he shall apply in writing to the Chairman R.M.C Jeypore before the end of the time period allowed in work order on account of which he desires such extension as aforesaid and the Chairman R.M.C Jeypore shall if in his opinion (which shall be final) allow the extension as per his decision.

3-15- SUPERVISION OF WORK.

The execution of all works, and quality of the materials supplied by the contractor shall be supervised by Electrical wings of the TPSODL.

3-16-DEDUCTION OF GST, INCOME TAX:

As per the prevailing rules of state as well as Central Govt. the GST & Income tax and 1% worker welfare cess will be deducted from the bill of work of the contractor.

SECTION- V

Exclusive terms and conditions for P/S work

5-1 Materials to be used

- a) LT line (AB Cable): The materials to be used and works to be done for erection of 1 km of L.T. line with A.B. Cable on 200 Kg. PSC pole of 30 mtr span has been mentioned. The contractor shall have to use the materials and execute the works proportionately to the scope of L.T. line (ABC) as mentioned for the project.
- b) L.T. Line (Bare Conductor): The materials to be used and the works to be done for erection of 1 km of LT line with 34 mm² AAA conductor on 200 kg PSC pole of 50 mt. span has been mentioned. The contractor shall have to use the materials and execute the works proportionately to the scope of LT line (AAAAC) as mentioned for the project.
- c) The contractor has to use the materials as per the specification and Guaranteed Technical Particulars as follows i.e. of AB Switch and HG Fuse, Supports, conductor etc (technically sanctioned estimates) are to be followed inherently during construction.
- d) The details of drawing is being given in the technically sanctioned estimates for the major materials like Pole, AB switch, HG Fuse, L.A.s, Angle, Channel etc. The work shall be executed as per the specification.
 - a. Single line diagram
 - b. Substation line diagram with earthing system.
- e) The contractor has to provide TPPSODL the work plan details for execution of entire work for supervision of the work.
- f) The contractor is responsible to obtain way leave for proposed new alignment of 11KV line & S/S as per clause-9 of OERC distribution (Condition of Supply) code-2004. Necessary undertaking by court affidavit is to be submitted by the contractor before execution of work,
- g) The Single Line Diagram must be approved by the Electrical Engineer before the executing the work.

5.2 Scope of Work

The detail scope of work has been mentioned in the tender schedule of price bid. The scope of work may be altered by Chairman R.M.C Jeypore depending of field situations. The contractor shall execute all such works at the unit rates quoted after setting written order from Chairman R.M.C Jeypore.

5.3 Approval of Electrical Inspector

The contractor on completion of work shall arrange for inspection of Electrical Inspector/Deputy Electrical Inspector and obtain the approval for charging and one copy of the approval shall be submitted to Chairman R.M.C Jeypore along with the bill of the work.

5.4 Liaison with TPSODL

The contractor shall have to do liaison with TPSODL for execution of the work. The service connection and security deposit charges required for agreement will be borne by Chairman R.M.C Jeypore. The contractor shall have to arrange the collection of the estimates from TPSODL for service connection and security deposits. The copy of agreement and the M.R. of deposits shall be submitted to Chairman R.M.C Jeypore by the contractor. The contractor shall also do liaison with TPSODL for connection short down charging of S/S and handing over to TPSODL after completion. The formalities needed for charging of LT line i.e. collection & submission of test report, preparation of check list liaison for installation of energy meter etc will be done by the contractor. The cost of energy meter will be borne by Chairman R.M.C Jeypore.

The Chairman R.M.C Jeypore will furnish the required letters to Electrical Inspector/TPSODL for the works mentioned above, as and when required.

5.5 Scope of Work

The scope of works of different items for this project is as per technically sanctioned estimates.
